Purpose

The purpose of this Program Instruction is to provide you with a revised final allocation schedule for Title III-D of the Older Americans Act for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1995.

Background

The 1995 Title III-D application transmitted via 94-PI-34, dated 8/29/94, included a question for each Area Agency to indicate its interest in receiving additional Title III-D funds should any become available. Listed below are the Area Agencies that did **not** apply for their FFY '95 Title III-D funds:

St. Regis Mohawk  
Saratoga  
Seneca Indian Reservation

The FFY '95 Title III-D funds which were not requested by the above Area Agencies have been re-allocated to the Area Agencies that expressed interest in receiving additional funds.

## Revised Final FFY 1995 Title III-D Allocation Schedule

Attached is the revised final Title III-D schedule for FFY '95 which reflects the revised allocation levels after re-allocation. Please note that the "Original Allocation" amounts are lower than the tentative allocations transmitted with 94-PI-40, dated 10/13/94. As explained in 94-PI-48, dated 12/20/94, which transmitted the FFY '95 Title III Final Allocation Schedules, our Office's FFY '95 Title III-D allotment is greater than our FFY '94 allotment, however, it was less than the allocation level used in the tentative schedule. Therefore, the lower final base allocation amounts are reflected on the attached re-allocation schedule. Please note that the supplements are **one-time** in nature and will not be used in calculating future allocation levels.

### Required Action

Since each Area Agency's final allocation amount, including the one-time supplement, is higher than the tentative allocation level included in its Title III-D application, it will be necessary for SOFA to issue revised Notifications of Grant Award to authorize the expenditure of the additional Title III-D funds. For those AAA's which receive \$5,000 or less in total Title III-D funds for 1995 (base allocation, supplement and carryover) the State Office for the Aging will prepare and issue revised Notifications of Grant Award and Budget Narrative pages reflecting the increased allocation levels.

Those Area Agencies receiving more than \$5,000 in Title III-D funds for 1995 must prepare a budget modification request, in accordance with 91-PI-24, incorporating the additional Title III-D funds. It is not required that you complete the Title III-D budget modification at this time. However, when you need to request a budget modification during the year for some other reason, such as to include actual carryover, your final base allocation and one-time supplement (if any) should be reflected in the budget modification request. In the event that you do not require a budget modification during the year for another reason, your Title III-D modification request must be submitted no later than November 1, 1995 (i.e., sixty (60) days prior to the end of the program period).
